

Feast of the Assumption this Wednesday! This Wednesday, August 15, we celebrate the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Please note our combined Mass schedule with Guardian Angels:

This Feast was formally promulgated in 1950 by Pope Pius XII, however it is not a "new" feast.
