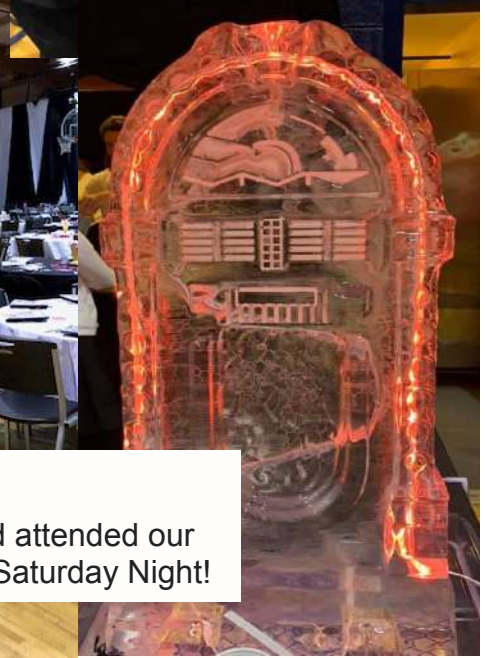
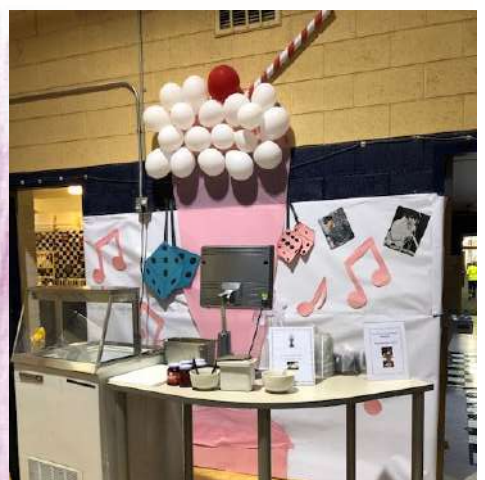
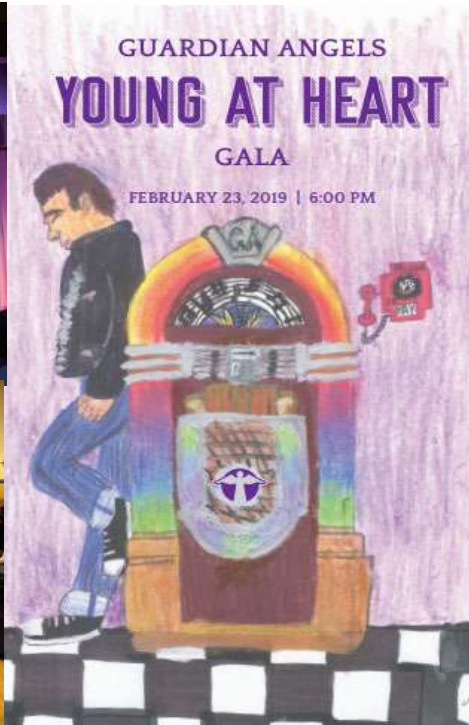

Last Saturday our gala was a tremendous success and I am most grateful to all who helped out in so many ways to make it a truly incredible evening. I thank



Archbishop Hebda for joining us and he expressed what a good time he had with us! Last year 121 attended, and this year we had over 200! We don't know the totals yet for what was raised, but it seems certain to be much higher than last year. The momentum is building! Thank you all! God is good!

The Abuse Crisis

Bishops from around the world met with the Holy Father in Rome last week to address the priest sexual abuse crisis that has so deeply hurt so many victims and greatly harmed the credibility of the Church. Some have complained that this Vatican meeting was "too little too late", or that it was merely a public relations stunt, and that the Church has failed, and will continue to fail, to address this great evil.

Yet, as I highlighted in a homily last fall, great progress has been made in our own archdiocese in addressing abuse over the past 30 years. Our own archdiocese began openly confronting priest sexual abuse in the late 1980's. The recent archdiocesan abuse bankruptcy settlement sadly included over 400 victims. However, just 2 of those cases occurred in the past 30 years. The priest involved was removed from the priesthood and went to prison. Of course, that is two children too many, and it was devastating for the two children, who are brothers, and their family. But the lack of abuse cases in recent times speaks to the reality that there has been tremendous progress to eliminate this evil in our archdiocese. People both within and beyond the church need to know this. From the many reports in the news one can easily get the impression that children are often abused by priests today and that simply is not true.

If progress can be made here, it can certainly be made in other parts of the world as well. I ask you to please continue to pray for healing for the victims, for the Church, and for a future that will see this completely eliminated from the life of the Church. The meetings in Rome do represent real progress, and I am confident that progress will continue to be made in all levels of the church, and in all countries, and places of the church throughout the world.
