## “Unplanned” Abortion Movie a Surprising Success to Film Industry



If you haven't yet seen the film “Unplanned” I highly recommend that you do. It documents the story of Abby Johnson who worked at an abortion clinic for many years and oversaw 22,000 abortions before coming to a place of conversion and realizing the evil that she was taking part in. She is now a strong pro-life advocate. The nationwide response has so surprised the theater industry that it is in 600 more theaters now than during its opening weekend (1700+ theaters now). The film was given an R rating against the wishes of the Christian filmmakers who want people, especially teens to see it. The R rating was given because near the beginning of the film is shown the ultrasound image of a baby being sucked from the womb as the child struggles for its life. Yes, it is a difficult to watch as it does show the graphic horror of abortion, but that is exactly the reality that people need to see and understand. When people see other people being treated cruelly, we all instinctually react against it. We know that it is wrong. The tragic and crazy irony is that our society deems a sixteen year old can legally have an abortion without parental consent, but cannot legally go to a movie warning about the evil of abortion without parental consent. Please note, however, that a youth under 17 can go to an R rated film as long as the parent accompanies the teen, or buys the ticket at the box office for the teen. So parents please know that you can bring your teen to see this movie. If you are unsure, go see it yourself first, and then make the judgment on whether to have your child watch it. It is showing at the Waconia Theater and others around the metro. I urge you to please see it.

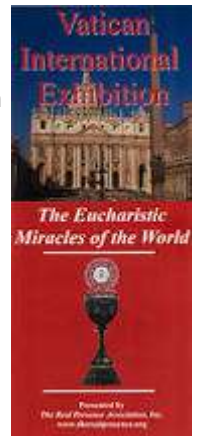
