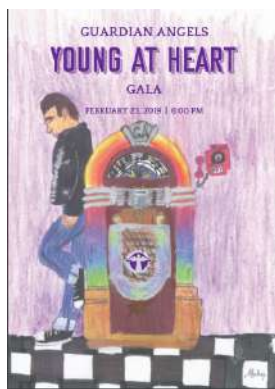

Pentecost Vigil Mass and Prayer Meeting ahead of Archdiocesan Synod Process
