## Fr. Galarza's New Assignment

Last week we announced that Fr. Galarza will be receiving a new assignment to the parish of Our Risen Savior in Burnsville, and Regions Hospital in St. Paul. It is very sad to lose Fr. Galarza, but as priests we are called to serve where the Archbishop calls us to go. Fr. Galarza has generously responded to the Archbishop's call to serve the Spanish community in Burnsville and Regions Hospital. The Spanish Mass at Risen Savior parish is very large with 600-800 Spanish speaking people every week. That is more than our Spanish Sunday Masses at Carver, Chaska, and Shakopee combined. The religious order of Spanish speaking priests who have been serving there, recently decided to return to their native Puerto Rico to minister to the people on that hurricane ravaged island. There is thus a very great need for Spanish Ministry at Risen Savior, that the Archdiocese must address beginning July 1. I ask us all to please be understanding with the changes that must occur with Masses at both St. Nicholas and Guardian Angels. I know that it can be difficult, but I also know that the Lord will lead us. I ask for your understanding, support, and prayers.

## St. Nicholas Property and Finance Council Approves Budget for 2019-2020 and New Windows for the Parish Rectory

This past Tuesday the Property and Finance Council approved a balanced budget including a small surplus for the coming fiscal year that begins on July 1. The council also recommended that the windows in our historic rectory/office be replaced. The window replacements have been approved by the Carver Historic Preservation Board and will be made of wood with wood lattice on either side of double paned energy efficient glass. They will cost more than your typical window because they are custom sized, and all wood, but they will save energy, while preserving the historic structure that we are blessed to have.
