

Pr. Gjengdahl creció en el Norte de San Pablo, fue graduado de la escuela secundaria North St. Paul en 1999. Luego asistió la universidad de North Dakota State para estudiar ingeniería. Si bien ha sido católico durante mucho tiempo, fue hasta la universidad cuando su fe cobró vida. Después de estudiar 2 años ingeniería, Pr. Gjengdahl ingresó al Seminario Cardinal Muench en Fargo, Dakota del Norte y se graduó con una licenciatura en filosofía en mayo del 2003. En el otoño, fue ingresado al seminario de San Pablo en la universidad de San Tomás. Fue ordenado Sacerdote en el año 2007 y fue nombrado vicario parroquial en Santa Odilia en Shoreview, MN.

Después de Santa Odilia, Pr. Gjengdahl fue asignado como vicario parroquial de San Juan Neumann en Eagan así como Capellán de medio tiempo en la academia San Tomás en Mendota Heights. Después de un año su asignación pasó a tiempo completo. Este cambio le permitió ser maestro de tiempo completo y ministro sacramental de la escuela. Enseñó varias asignaturas, incluyendo moralidad, los sacramentos, la historia de la Iglesia, las religiones del mundo y la enseñanza social católica e incluso entró al frisbee.

Friendly Reminder - No Cell Phone Use While Driving

As of August 1, 2019, the new law goes into effect.

What can I do under the new law?

The new law allows a driver to use their cell phone to make calls, text, listen to music or podcasts and get directions, but only by voice commands or single-touch activation without holding the phone.

Remember, hands-free is not necessarily distraction-free.

What can't I do with my phone under the new law?

You may not hold your phone in your hand. Also, a driver may not use their phone at any time for video calling, video live-streaming, Snapchat, gaming, looking at video or photos stored on the phone, using non-navigation apps, reading texts and scrolling or typing on the phone.

Can I ever hold my phone?

Yes. Hand-held phone use is allowed to obtain emergency assistance, if there is an immediate threat to life and safety, or when in an authorized emergency vehicle while performing official duties.

Can I use a GPS navigation device?

Yes. GPS and other systems that can only be used for navigation are exempt from the Hands-Free law. In-car screens and systems are also exempt. In both cases, most of these systems lock when the vehicle is moving.

UNA MENTALIDAD DE SERVICIO

Hay varios viajes, entregas y visitas que pasan en las lecturas de hoy. En el libro del Génesis, Abraham atiende las necesidades de los tres viajeros misteriosos. La respuesta del salmo, celebra la justicia que Abraham practica. Entonces, en su carta a los colosenses, san Pablo describe su propio ministerio como algo que es para darse como servicio: él, administrador de Dios, trae la palabra de Dios a su comunidad. Finalmente, el Evangelio de Lucas, comparte la historia bien conocida de Marta y María, y la manera diferente como recibieron en su casa a Jesús. 
TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Esta cobija colorida, de algodón o lana, fue desarrollada para añadir color y belleza a los charros de siglos pasados.

A través de la historia el sarape ha sido usado por vaqueros, jinetes, soldados y revolucionarios. Hoy día el sarape, jorongo, frazada, gabán o cobija se ha convertido en símbolo de tradición mexicana y se encuentra decorando hogares, restaurantes e iglesias. México no es el único país que ha desarrollado un mestizaje en tela, también Guatemala, Colombia, El Salvador y otros más tienen sus telas y tapetes particulares que mezclan los colores y los diseños para celebrar el talento y la creatividad del mestizaje latinoamericano.
