

Baptismal prep sessions are given every other month and Baptism Masses are held once a month. Call Jean in the Parish Office to schedule a child for Baptism and the parents for baptismal prep.

Penance: Saturdays at Guardian Angels or by appointment.

Matrimony: Pre-registration required at least one year in advance; marriage preparation course is required. Initial contact: 952-227-4000, or e-mail: info@Gachaska.org.

Anointing: If you wish to receive an anointing please call the Parish Office: (952) 227-4000.

Communion for the Homebound: When we come together to pray at our Eucharistic liturgy, we do not forget the members of our community who are unable to be with us because of ill health. We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. We are not always aware of those who have this need. Please call the Parish Office to let us know if you or a member of your family would like to have Holy Communion brought to them. That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

Hospital, Nursing Home, Homebound Visits: Churches are no longer notified by hospitals or nursing homes when a parishioner is admitted unless the family has requested it. If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call Jean in the Parish Office.

GA School off to a great start!

This week our Guardian Angels School began a new year with great joy and anticipation as children and teachers returned to the classroom refreshed and ready to go. This year we are particularly excited as we are experiencing a significant boost in enrollment for the first time in many years.

As of the first day of school we have 81 students enrolled in PreK-8. Last year we began with 67. We're still too small, but we are moving in the right direction. This is the most students that we have had since I arrived in 2017. Even more importantly, we're doing much better now drawing students into our pre-school and kindergarten classes which is critical in building future enrollment.

I have heard many people say that we should simply close our school and be done with it. I can certainly appreciate these sentiments given the decades long slide in enrollment, and the many challenges that we face. But I truly believe that we are now experiencing a significant turnaround and that good things are ahead if we continue to build on our recent success. I humbly ask us all to continue to do what we can to support our school as we seek to move toward a more vibrant future. It will take time and effort by all of us, but I believe that it is well worth it. I am confident that we will continue to see increasing fruits of our prayerful and determined efforts to form our children in the Catholic faith. We are blessed with a great legacy that has been handed to us from those who have faithfully gone before us. Now we have the opportunity in our time to build on that legacy.

There are still several families with preschoolers that are touring our school and discerning their options. We hope that there will be even more students in the coming months. Please let people know about our beloved GA school and please spread the word about our great school. 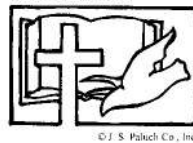
