Anointing: If you wish to receive an anointing please call the Parish Office: (952) 227-4000.

Communion for the Homebound: When we come together to pray at our Eucharistic liturgy, we do not forget the members of our community who are unable to be with us because of ill health. We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. We are not always aware of those who have this need. Please call the Parish Office to let us know if you or a member of your family would like to have Holy Communion brought to them. That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

Hospital, Nursing Home, Homebound Visits: Churches are no longer notified by hospitals or nursing homes when a parishioner is admitted unless the family has requested it. If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call Jean in the Parish Office.

Weekly Adoration and Benediction now at GA School, Mass Time Change Too

Beginning on Sept. 24, we will add a separate session of Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction at our GA School. Last year we began doing this briefly after some of the school Masses, but now there will be a separate dedicated time. Every Tuesday from 3:10 to 3:35 p.m. the third through eighth grades will gather in the Church. Parents and parishioners are most welcome to attend. If you see our GA students glowing a little more brightly with the love of Jesus, perhaps this is why! We're singing the *O'salutaris Hostia* and *Tantum ergo Sacramentum* in English to start off, and then we'll transition into the Latin over time. It is so important that our children spend this beautiful time of prayer with Jesus and be formed in this time-honored tradition of the Church. Jesus is always present to us in the Blessed Sacrament and Adoration is one of the best ways for our children and all of us to slow down, turn off the electronic devices and distractions of our day, and simply experience the Lord's quiet love for us in the Blessed Sacrament. Our School Mass is still on Wednesdays, but the time has changed to 10:00 a.m.

Scam ALERT!

Recently there have been lots of scams occurring in which people are texted or emailed supposedly from their pastor in which the priest asks for some kind of financial help such as gift cards for someone who is supposedly in need. Always be careful of any email or text that you receive.

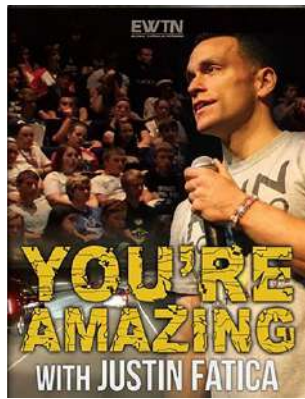

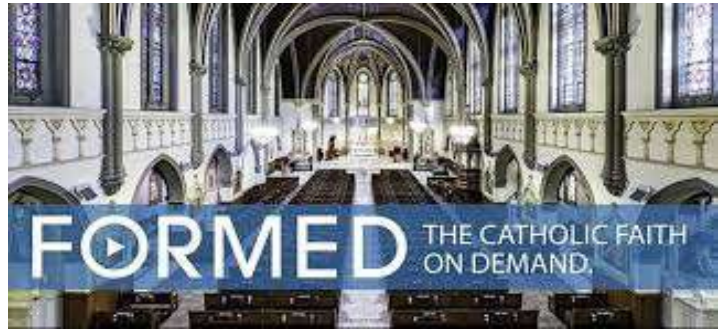


Volunteers Needed for Fall Festival

Es muy triste pensar que algunas personas tratan de aprovechar la buena voluntad entre un pastor y los feligreses para obtener ganancias egoístas. Siempre tenga cuidado con cualquier correo electrónico o mensaje de texto que reciba.

Acerca del Evangelio 15 de Septiembre de 2019 Luke 15:1-32 or 15:1-10



Las ovejas aprenden a conocer la voz de su pastor y el rebaño viene cuando él las llama. Si una oveja se pierde, el pastor se daría cuenta y la buscaría. Nosotros somos el rebaño de Jesús. Si alguno de nosotros se aleja de él (mediante el pecado), él continúa llamándonos y trata de encontrarnos. Él es un pastor lleno de amor.
