

Communion for the Homebound: When we come together to pray at our Eucharistic liturgy, we do not forget the members of our community who are unable to be with us because of ill health. We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. We are not always aware of those who have this need. Please call the Parish Office to let us know if you or a member of your family would like to have Holy Communion brought to them. That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

Hospital, Nursing Home, Homebound Visits: Churches are no longer notified by hospitals or nursing homes when a parishioner is admitted unless the family has requested it. If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call Jean in the Parish Office.

Feast of the Immaculate Conception

This Sunday, December 8 (today), is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Because it is on a Sunday this year, the actual celebration will be tomorrow, Monday, December 9. However, it is **not** a Holy Day of Obligation this year. We will still have a Mass celebrating this Great Marian Feast on Monday at 10 a.m. at Guardian Angels with the school children. Please come, if you can, and celebrate Mary, who was conceived without the stain of original sin. Her conception by a singular grace of God, in view of Salvation in Christ, allowed her to be the pure vessel for Jesus Christ, the Son of God. Mary's conception within the womb of her mother Anne is the beginning of the break of the long history of sin that began with Adam and Eve. The Blessed Mother conceived sinless, remained sinless throughout her life. This is best exemplified when she said YES to the Angel Gabriel and to God's miraculous will that she would conceive of the Holy Spirit and bear the child Jesus. With Christ, we now all can receive the grace to break the bonds of sin and death through his death on the cross and resurrection. Mary Immaculate is the patroness of the United States as decreed by Pope Pius IX in 1847. In Washington D.C. there is a huge, and beautiful Basilica dedicated to the Immaculate Conception in honor of Mary's title as patroness of our country. If you ever get to D.C. on vacation, please be sure to see this beautiful church which holds 6000 on the main floor, and 4000 in the crypt below.

Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe this Thursday

This Thursday, December 12, we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. We'll have Mass in Spanish at 7:00 p.m. at Guardian Angels with a fiesta afterward in the gym. Even if you don't speak Spanish, it is a wonderful celebration to be a part of. The music is always so beautiful and uplifting. Fr. Mario, who offers our Spanish Mass on Sundays, will be the celebrant. We'll also celebrate the feast in English at our regular Thursday, 8 a.m. Mass at Guardian Angels. It is not often that we celebrate two great Marian Feasts in the same week! What great opportunities for grace we are given this week! Our Lady of Guadalupe is the patroness of all the Americas -North, South, and Central America. Mary Immaculate, Our Lady of Guadalupe; Pray for us!
