A Complete Reversal

In our gospel today, Jesus calls “happy” those who we would not normally see in an enviable position in life. And Jesus utters an emphatic lament over those who we would normally regard as happy. How are we to take this?

In order to understand Jesus’ reversal of values better, it is good to put ourselves in the place of the disciples. They were indeed genuinely poor. They had left everything in order to share in Jesus’ life of want. They were genuinely hungry, and this was something that they had in common with many people of the time. They were taught to have sympathy and not pass by those who had want and sorrow, but to weep with those who weep. Soon, they themselves were about to be severely mistreated and brought into disrepute like their Master.

Jesus consoles them, saying that you will be satisfied, and will laugh, and receive a great reward in heaven. He said to them that now you are suffering, but later you will enjoy great happiness. Knowing this, you can already rejoice now. Heaven is shining through your present trouble.

There have been many “isms” in the world that have promised a different result without having to heed Jesus’ words. Today, it is capitalism. Its beatitudes are radically different. Blessed are those who are successful and speedy. Blessed is the good life and those whose name is in every mouth.

But Jesus does not turn his gaze away from those who are standing in the shadows of life and neither can we. There are those who are poor, displaced through migration, orphaned by divorce or unemployed. Jesus’ call is directed to them today: “Society may exclude you, but in my eyes, you are completely worthwhile to me.”

When we follow Jesus, we have to revise our values. Success is good, but people are more important. Enjoying life is pleasant, but it is not everything. There are many things only trouble can teach us. How can I and my parish come in contact more with the people Jesus calls blessed? How will this teach me true blessedness?

Communion for the Homebound: When we come together to pray at our Eucharistic liturgy, we do not forget the members of our community who are unable to be with us because of ill health. We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. We are not always aware of those who have this need. Please call the Parish Office to let us know if you or a member of your family would like to have Holy Communion brought to them. That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

Hospital, Nursing Home, Homebound Visits: Churches are no longer notified by hospitals or nursing homes when a parishioner is admitted unless the family has requested it. If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call the Parish Office.



Una inversión completa

En nuestro evangelio de hoy, Jesús llama “felices” a aquellos que normalmente no veríamos en una posición envidiable en la vida. Y Jesús lanza un enfático lamento por aquellos a quienes normalmente consideraríamos felices. ¿Cómo vamos a tomar esto? Para comprender mejor la inversión de valores de Jesús, es bueno ponerse en el lugar de los discípulos. De hecho, eran genuinamente pobres. Habían dejado todo para compartir la vida de necesidad de Jesús. Estaban realmente hambrientos, y esto era algo que tenían en común con mucha gente de la época. Se les enseñó a tener simpatía y no pasar por alto a los que tenían miseria y tristeza, sino a llorar con los que lloran. Pronto, ellos mismos estaban a punto de ser severamente maltratados y desacreditados como su Maestro. Jesús los consuela, diciéndoles que se saciarán, se reirán y recibirán una gran recompensa en el cielo. Les dijo que ahora estáis sufriendo, pero después disfrutaréis de una gran felicidad. Sabiendo esto, ya puedes regocijarte ahora. El cielo está brillando a través de tu presente problema. Ha habido muchos “ismos” en el mundo que han prometido un resultado diferente sin tener que hacer caso a las palabras de Jesús. Hoy es el capitalismo. Sus bienaventuranzas son radicalmente diferentes. Bienaventurados los que tienen éxito y son rápidos. Bendita la buena vida y aquellos cuyo nombre está en cada boca. Pero Jesús no aparta su mirada de aquellos que están parados en las sombras de la vida y nosotros tampoco podemos. Están los que son pobres, desplazados por la migración, huérfanos por el divorcio o desempleados. A ellos se dirige hoy la llamada de Jesús: “La sociedad os puede excluir, pero a mis ojos me valéis por completo”. Cuando seguimos a Jesús, tenemos que revisar nuestros valores. El éxito es bueno, pero las personas son más importantes. Disfrutar de la vida es agradable, pero no lo es todo. Hay muchas cosas que solo los problemas pueden enseñarnos. ¿Cómo puedo yo y mi parroquia estar más en contacto con las personas que Jesús llama bienaventuradas? ¿Cómo me enseñará esto la verdadera bienaventuranza?
