If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call the Parish Office.

## THE COST OF DISCIPLESHIP

In our gospel today we see that Jesus is resolutely determined to go on his way. And he seems harsh to those who want to follow him. To one, he points out that he is homeless and has nowhere to rest his head. To another who wants to bury his father first, he says, “Let the dead bury their dead, but you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God.” To a third, he says, “No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God. Is he being too harsh? But then how do we go our way – hesitantly or in decided fashion? Is there a goal that we know we must reach? Are our lives marked by a clear purpose or do we muddle through alternating between duty and entertainment? Jesus gives his followers a sense of direction and showed them the meaning of life. He said that the kingdom of God was at hand.

And it is now. Jesus’ goal was Jerusalem. There he intends to give up his very life for all – not to compel his followers to do anything, but to free them from the compulsion of sin. That is what they have to learn from him so as to become like him themselves. This is the way of love and it requires courage and strength. We have many things that we are being called to do at Guardian Angels, including renovating our friary at what I am sure you will agree to be a significant cost, engage in learning and inviting others to learn about our faith, and befriend and serve those around us who are less fortunate. But we know that Jesus will give us the grace to do whatever he calls us to do. For the past two thousand years so many men and women have left everything to follow him on the adventure of discipleship. If you asked them, would they say that they regretted it? I don’t think so. We find that we overcome our weaknesses and our doubts. We find true meaning in life when we truly follow him with all of our hearts.

## EL COSTO DEL DISCIPULADO

En nuestro evangelio de hoy vemos que Jesús está decididamente decidido a seguir su camino. Y parece duro con los que quieren seguirlo. A uno, le señala que no tiene hogar y no tiene dónde descansar la cabeza. A otro que quiere enterrar primero a su padre, le dice: “Deja que los muertos entierren a sus muertos, pero tú, ve y proclama el reino de Dios”. A un tercero le dice: “Nadie que pone la mano en el arado y mira lo que ha quedado atrás es apto para el reino de Dios. ¿Está siendo demasiado duro? Pero entonces, ¿cómo seguimos nuestro camino, vacilantes o de manera decidida? ¿Hay una meta que sabemos que debemos alcanzar? ¿Nuestras vidas están marcadas por un propósito claro o alternamos entre el deber y el entretenimiento? Jesús da a sus seguidores un sentido de dirección y les muestra el sentido de la vida. Dijo que el reino de Dios estaba cerca. Y lo es ahora. El objetivo de Jesús era Jerusalén. Allí tiene la intención de dar su propia vida por todos, no para obligar a sus seguidores a hacer nada, sino para liberarlos de la compulsión del pecado. Eso es lo que tienen que aprender de él para llegar a ser ellos mismos como él. Este es el camino del amor y requiere coraje y fuerza. Tenemos muchas cosas a las que estamos llamados a hacer en Guardian Angels, incluida la renovación de nuestro convento a un costo que estoy seguro de que estará de acuerdo en que será un costo significativo, participar en el aprendizaje e invitar a otros a aprender sobre nuestra fe, y entablar amistad y servir a aquellos a nuestro alrededor que son menos afortunados. Pero sabemos que Jesús nos dará la gracia de hacer lo que él nos llame a hacer. Durante los últimos dos mil años, tantos hombres y mujeres han dejado todo para seguirlo en la aventura del discipulado. Si les preguntaras, ¿dirían que se arrepintieron? No me parece. Descubrimos que superamos nuestras debilidades y nuestras dudas. Encontramos verdadero significado en la vida cuando realmente lo seguimos con todo nuestro corazón.


