Communion for the Homebound: When we come together to pray at our Eucharistic liturgy, we do not forget the members of our community who are unable to be with us because of ill health. We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. We are not always aware of those who have this need. Please call the Parish Office to let us know if you or a member of your family would like to have Holy Communion brought to them. That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

Hospital, Nursing Home, Homebound Visits: Churches are no longer notified by hospitals or nursing homes when a parishioner is admitted unless the family has requested it. If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call the Parish Office.

TEACH US TO PRAY!

Have you ever seen someone deep in prayer? It is a beautiful sight to behold! What is it that is happening inside such a person? Whenever Jesus prayed, it must have left a deep impression on the disciples. They often saw him praying sometimes all night long. What happened within him? Certainly, no one dared to disturb him until he was finished in our gospel today.

The best person to teach about prayer is someone who prays themselves. And Jesus does not give a course on prayer or even methods of how to pray. He seems to say that praying can only be learned by praying. But if you do want to pray, then do it in the words of the "Our Father".

The entire Lord's Prayer can be encapsulated in one word, "Father!" In his own language, he said, "Abba", the trusting, childlike "Dad." So a childlike trust is basic in the prayer that he gives us.

What should we ask for? Should we even ask for things at all? Yes, but first of all we should ask for the most important thing: "Your kingdom come." This takes the first place and this sets everything in our lives in its rightful place. Then we should have what we need: our daily bread, God's forgiveness, and forgiveness of each other, and being kept from going astray. This is very simple and very clear. Praying every day, "Our Father", will foster trust in God and set our lives in order.

¿Alguna vez has visto a alguien en profunda oración? ¡Es una hermosa vista para la vista! ¿Qué es lo que está pasando dentro de una persona así? Cada vez que Jesús oraba, debe haber dejado una profunda impresión en los discípulos. A menudo lo veían rezar a veces durante toda la noche. ¿Qué pasó dentro de él? Ciertamente, nadie se atrevió a molestarlo hasta que terminó en nuestro evangelio de hoy. La mejor persona para enseñar acerca de la oración es alguien que ora por sí mismo. Y Jesús no da un curso sobre la oración o incluso métodos de cómo orar. Parece decir que sólo se puede aprender a orar orando. Pero si quieres orar, hazlo con las palabras del "Padre Nuestro". Todo el Padrenuestro se puede resumir en una palabra, "¡Padre!" En su propio idioma, dijo: "Abba", el confiado e infantil "papá". Así que una confianza de niño es básica en la oración que nos da. ¿Qué debemos pedir? ¿Deberíamos siquiera pedir cosas? Sí, pero antes que nada debemos pedir lo más importante: "Venga tu reino". Esto toma el primer lugar y esto pone todo en nuestras vidas en el lugar que le corresponde. Entonces deberíamos tener lo que necesitamos: nuestro pan de cada día, el perdón de Dios y el perdón de unos a otros, y ser guardados para no descarriarnos. Esto es muy simple y muy claro. Rezar todos los días, "Padre Nuestro", fomentará la confianza en Dios y pondrá en orden nuestra vida.


