RESTING ON THE SABBATH AND THE WORKPLACE

I often hear someone say to me that “I couldn’t go to church because I had to work.” But after asking several questions about the matter, it is often the case that the person with whom I talked could’ve found another Mass at another time to attend, even if it had to be at another parish. It is amazing to me how much we know about so many things in our information age, but how little we know about Mass times around our living area. For example, many fellow Catholics will go to the 6:00 PM Sunday Mass in Chanhassen in order to fulfill their Sunday obligation when all else fails and their weekend commitments prove to be too prohibitive to go to their regular Mass.

Sometimes our workplaces do demand that we work on Saturdays and Sundays in such a way as to make Mass very difficult to attend. But I don’t say this lightly. The most common example is a nurse at a hospital who works the 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday weekend shifts. But this is really the most exceptional case that I have encountered.

I remember having a pizza delivery job before I enrolled in the seminary. My employer knew that I would work very hard on Friday and Saturday nights and could be relied upon to take those shifts, but that Sunday was not in my wheelhouse. He knew this because we had simply talked about it. This is what I encourage you to do. Simply talk it over with your employer.

I say this in light of a recent Supreme Court decision that affirmed much more meaningfully, the right of an employee to request accommodation to be able to rest on the Sabbath. For Catholics, it is okay to work on Sunday if it really helps the employer, but we should explore with our employer as much as we can the ability to go to Sunday Mass, with our employer. If we worked the full day every Sunday and went to Mass, it may be advisable to find one’s way out of this situation if we were chronically stuck in it. The Supreme Court decision strengthened the rights of a worker by interpreting that denial of such a religious accommodation should mean that an employer must show that doing so would create a significant difficulty or expense. I reprint the USCCB’s summary of the ruling here.

“Today, in a unanimous ruling, the Supreme Court of the United States breathed life back into a major civil rights law meant to prevent discrimination by employers against people of faith in the workplace. The case, *Groff v. DeJoy*, was about a postal service worker whose religious beliefs require him to rest on the Sabbath, and who was punished for following that belief. The Supreme Court recognized that its previous ruling in a case called *TWA v. Hardison* had been wrongly interpreted to narrow protections for religious employees under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act, and the Court corrected that error.”

“In so many ways today we see people of faith being told that they can only follow their religious beliefs in private or within the four walls of a church,” said Cardinal Timothy M. Dolan of New York, chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops’ (USCCB) Committee for Religious Liberty. “But religious freedom means nothing if it does not extend to the public square. And the public square is better off when religion is welcome there.”

Cardinal Dolan noted how the case relates to the efforts of many employers to honor diversity. “In the workplace we meet and collaborate with people from other walks of life. Working together requires navigating personal differences with compassion and respect – and that obligation applies to religious differences no less than others.”

We may need to have a good conversation about our desire to attend Mass with our employer, but doing so, at the very least, will be a good witness to our love of our Lord, Jesus Christ. Let’s not be afraid to take that step!

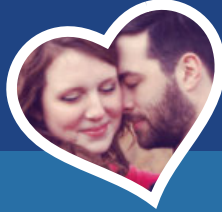

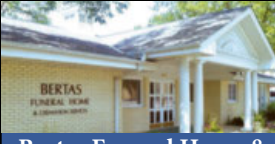
