## MAY GOD RENEW US THIS SUMMER!

Dear Friends, I would like to describe what I will be doing in these upcoming six weeks. I will be participating in the first annual Alverna Priestly Renewal Program in Winona at the Alverna Center near the campus of Saint Mary's University from July 1<sup>st</sup> to July 26<sup>th</sup>. My prayer is that it will be a time of great grace for me so that I can come back and serve you well as your pastor with renewed energy. The first week will focus on spiritual formation. More specifically, it will focus on prayer as a relationship, a heart-to-heart union with the Holy Trinity, concrete tools for daily prayer and the discernment of spirits. The second week will present an Ignatian retreat with a goal of encountering the Lord's love in a new way forward so that I can live my priesthood with joy. Week three will focus on human formation with the goal of meeting Christ through our humanity with a deeper understanding of my strengths and gifts and the healing of my wounds (yes, we have those!). During the last week, we will focus on pastoral application of all of these things and Christ-like leadership with an emphasis on how to recognize charisms that we all have and team building.

If these seem like lofty goals to you, you are on the right track. They are! No one reaches anything resembling perfection in these areas in four weeks, but it is important to take some things back to Chaska and Carver with me so that I can continue to learn from them. I really do think that this is the right thing for me at the right time. In 2020, I applied for a three-month sabbatical to go to a similar retreat for about one month and then two months of study of Spanish language in Querétaro, Mexico. I received approval for it, but then covid hit and the archbishop called and asked me to come here. The entire sabbatical was not possible anyway.

I view this time as a 21-year priest as similar to half time in a basketball or football game. You go in the locker room, get a good break and then come out ready. At forty years of priesthood I will be 75, so that will be a time of assessing where I am in terms of my health and ability to keep going and at what capacity.

This past year with our discernment team and our new strategic plan which features 25 new commissioners on four different commissions is an exciting development. I really look forward to advancing new plans for our parishes of Guardian Angels and Saint Nicholas. Pope Francis, in his apostolic exhortation, "The Joy of Evangelization," wrote:

"The parish is not an outdated institution, precisely because it possesses great flexibility, it can assume quite different contours depending on the openness and missionary creativity of the pastor and the community. While certainly not the only institution which evangelizes, the parish proves capable of self-renewal and constant adaptivity, it continues to be 'the Church living in the midst of the homes of her sons and daughters.' In all of its activities the parish encourages and trains its members to be evangelizers. It is a community of communities, a sanctuary where the thirsty come to drink in the midst of their journey, and a center of constant missionary outreach" (Evangelii Gadium, 28).

Can this missionary dream be a reality in our parishes? Let's continue to have these high hopes so well-expressed by our pope! Please pray for me as I pray for all of you and our parishes so that we can begin this labor of evangelization in the vineyard of the Lord with new vigor, ardor and expression! May God bless you in these next six weeks!
