## SAINT JOHN PAUL II IS A SAINT FOR OUR TIMES TODAY

On Tuesday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, we celebrated the memorial day of Saint John Paul II. As we approach election day and our civic consciousness increases in this very important time in our country, we can realize how great of a witness this saint was in our modern times. Certainly, he has had an impact on my life. I remember looking out behind me at the vast crowd in Rome at World Youth Day in 2000. I remember this beloved pope riding by with his eyes closed from fatigue, I presume, with a very big smile on his face as we all waved when he passed by.

In his homily at the inauguration of his Pontificate, he spoke about how Saint Peter went to Rome, the heart of the Roman Empire, to preach the gospel. He probably would have preferred to stay by the shores of the Sea of Galilee with his boat and his nets. Yet, guided by the Lord's inspiration he came to Rome. Tradition holds, according to Saint John Paul II, that Peter tried to leave Rome during Nero's persecution. However, the Lord intervened and came to meet him. Peter spoke to him and asked, "Where are you going, Lord?" And the Lord answered him, "I am going to Rome to be crucified again." Peter went back to Rome and stayed there until his own crucifixion.

Christ's mission is our mission, and this is so true in our modern times when we see so much breakdown in our society and by extension, our government. We see the lack of regard for the sacredness of human life, lack of respect for religious freedom, reckless and out-of-touch spending, and often little or no regard for those who are poor or marginalized. Christ's mission: Priest, Prophet-Teacher, and King -- continues in the church. We share in his saving work by proclaiming the gospel with our words and our acts of charity. We become his hands and feet. Our voice is one of witness to his great power and love.

The power of the Lord is a power that has its source in the mystery of the Cross and Resurrection. This is a power that is absolute and yet sweet and gentle. It speaks to the depths of our whole being, in terms of our loftiest aspirations of our intellect, will, and heart and does so in charity and truth. We know this when we come to Mass and experience this power once again.

So, our late pope and saint exhorted the people, "Do not be afraid to welcome Christ and to accept His power... Be not afraid. Open, I say open wide the doors to Christ." He went on to say that Christ alone knows what is inside of us. Often, we don't know what is inside of us. So let Christ speak to man. He alone has the words of eternal life. We let Christ speak to others around us when we pray that the Lord cast off all fear and participate in our political process in our civil society. We bring our Catholic understanding of Jesus to the public square in hope of a better world. We let Christ speak to others when we give witness to Him by our words and actions through such activities as volunteering for a role in our faith formation, engaging civilly in a discussion about a respect for life with our relatives, and performing a work of charity on behalf of our family members. I wonder sometimes if doubt about our abilities holds us back. Yet, we know that Jesus gives us all we need to do that which he has called us to do. Let us always rely on His power and His strength and His desire to bring hearts close to Him.
