CLARETIAN MISSIONARIES

Note from Father Tony: We will welcome Father Wenceslaus Isidienu from the Claretian Missionaries on July 5th and 6th. He will make an appeal on behalf of his missionary congregation. Please join me in welcoming him to our parish and generously supporting the Claretians. Thank you.

The Claretian Missionaries is a religious Missionary Congregation founded by St. Anthony Mary Claret, in Spain, in 1849. Our Charism in the Church is to preach the Word of God using all possible means.

We Claretian Missionaries are presently involved in parish ministry teaching retreat preaching and publication. We work in more than 60 countries of the world.

In Nigeria we build and run schools to give quality and sound education to the youths. These schools are necessary because the government neglected this sector for a long time. We are also involved in Justice and Peace initiatives to empower the people like helping the poor and orphans get sponsors so that at least they can eat.

Recently Nigeria has had a lot of social unrest perpetrated by the Islamic fundamentalists known as BOKO HARAM (ISIS). This group promotes terrorism and violence at different levels. They operate more in Northern Nigeria where we have a good number of our Missionaries working. Terrorism and insurgency in the northern part of the country is affecting the Christians who dwell there. The violence being unleashed on the Christians has put them to fear, displacement and hunger and we as missionaries cannot fold our arms and watch our fellow missionaries and their parishioners suffer. Bombs have exploded and killed several Christians during Worship. Despite the violence, there is still hope of a flourishing faith.

To make matters worse, the COVID-19 pandemic with its economic and social effects brought hunger and death in the country. The palliatives provided by the government and nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) were hoarded by corrupt politicians. The church becomes solace for the poor and marginalized.

We also have a good number of young people who knock at our door indicating their interests to join us in the missionary work we do. We thank God for the increase in vocation to priesthood but most often we are financially handicapped as to taking care of the needs of these young men so that the work of evangelization will continue to spread.

Through your donations we the Claretian Missionaries will carry on with the work of evangelization. God bless you as you help us.


