



Tanzania Collection next weekend! Next weekend, we will take up a collection to assist the work of a priest friend of mine from Tanzania in Africa. I first met Fr. Augustine Mbiche when I was serving as an associate pastor at Pax Christi in Eden Prairie in 2005. At that time, Fr. Augustine was trying to start a kindergarten to help the many AIDS orphans in his village of Mtamba. It is estimated that there are around 3,000 AIDS orphans in the area who have lost one or both parents to that terrible disease. From humble beginnings, Father Augustine not only started a school, but it now goes up to 8th grade and is considered one of the best schools in the whole country of Tanzania. I was blessed to go there in 2015 to see for myself the tremendous work that Fr. Augustine has been able to accomplish. Next weekend, as part of our Lenten almsgiving, we will take up a collection to support this great work. The funds go to feed the students, provide them with uniforms, and to pay for the staff that is needed 24/7 to both educate and look after the children. Knowing and supporting Fr. Augustine has been one of the greatest joys of my life. You will probably get to meet him this summer when he will hopefully be able to come to the United States (he tries to visit every two years). I thank you for whatever you are able to offer. May God bless you for your Lenten almsgiving!
