In addition to voting, please pray for our country, our leaders, those to be elected, and for those who serve our country to defend the rights that we are so blessed to have.

Good News from Tanzania! This week, my good friend, Fr. Augustine Mbiche, called from Tanzania in Africa to share some great news. You may recall that Fr. Augustine came here this past summer and we took up a collection to support his K-7 school of St. Monica's in the village of Mtamba. Most of the students are orphans because one or both of their parents have died from the terrible AIDS epidemic that has hit that country very hard.

Father Augustine explained that the results of the national testing just came in and that their students did very well. So well, in fact, that out of more than 16,000 grade schools in Tanzania, their school ranked 126<sup>th</sup>. That means that their school is in the top 1% of all elementary schools in the country!

I congratulated Father Augustine on the accomplishment and promised our continued support. He thanked us for the support from Guardian Angels and St. Nicholas and he promised that he and the children will continue to offer their prayers for us.

Our contributions are having a profound impact on the lives of so many very poor children half way around the world. His school now has about 350 students and virtually all of them go on to high school, and most go on to college as well. Four of them have gone on to the seminary to study for the priesthood. When you think of it, we're not only helping those students, but the entire Church and nation of Tanzania as they grow into adulthood and then give back what they have received.
