to her even though his family was in need. When he returned home he found that his milk jug was still full even though he had offered it to her. She also is credited with saving some Portuguese sailors who

were rescued from a storm at sea through her presence and intercession.

We are all in need of good health and what a beautiful way to do this by praying to the Blessed Mother and asking for her assistance.
