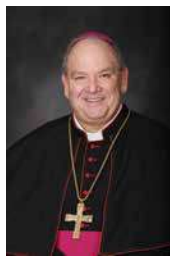

Judge approves Archdiocesan Bankruptcy Settlement! You probably saw in the news this past week that the archdiocesan bankruptcy settlement has now been approved by the judge. The victims have overwhelmingly voted in favor of the settlement as have the other parties involved including the archdiocese, parishes, insurance companies, etc. There is now a period of several weeks to appeal as required by law. Depending on whether there are any appeals, and how those appeals are resolved, will determine the actual date for the completion of the settlement. From what I have heard, it is expected that everything should be completely wrapped up before the end of this calendar year. Please continue to pray for a just and timely resolution for this settlement. Please continue to pray for all victims of abuse, and for the Church, and all the members of the Church. The healing needed will take many years, but hopefully for the victims and all the people of our archdiocese, this settlement will begin to turn a corner on the long road of healing.
